MSN Program Overview

For Registered Nurses with a Bachelor's Degree

Registered nurses with a bachelor's degree in nursing or another field who want to become a Certified Nurse-Midwife or Nurse Practitioner are eligible to apply to the MSN program. When you receive your MSN, you have the option to transition to the DNP program via a direct admission process and complete your advanced degree. You may also choose to exit at that time and return later to complete the DNP degree.
